Scripps is pleased to announce the 36th Annual Clinical Hematology & Oncology conference taking place February 13-16, 2016 in San Diego, California. The conference will be held at the Omni Hotel San Diego. Our annual program has been tremendously successful in the past and we continue to grow each year. We are expecting more than 400 hematology-oncology physicians to join us in February.

Our annual conference is designed for hematologists, oncologists, surgeons, radiation oncologists, internists, and others desiring an update in these specialty areas.
